Give To Colombia is a US-based nonprofit organization with 501(c)(3) status that aims to create, promote and facilitate alliances between international donors and Colombian grassroots organizations.

G2C was created to address the challenges experienced by international donors when supporting social initiatives in Colombia. Its primary goal is to optimize the social impact of private and institutional donors' investments in the social sector. We work to increase the flow of international donations by providing an effective and independent platform through which all types of donors can transparently channel their funds.

Our innovative social model has allowed us to raise \$20 million dollars in donations to support sustainable, innovative and high-impact projects in Colombia in the areas of Education, Health & Nutrition, Economic Development and Environment.

Give To Colombia's sound fiscal management practices and commitment to accountability and transparency have earned it a 4-star rating from Charity Navigator, America's largest independent charity evaluator.

Hablando con Julis

Technology is, without a doubt, one of the most useful tools available to modern society. This is especially relevant to people with cognitive or other types of disabilities.

What would be of Julis, a Colombian girl born a deaf-mute in a family where no one knew sign language, if not for the alternative language software *Hablando con Julis*? How would she tell us her wants, her likes? How would she communicate with her family members, her grandmother, her uncles and siblings?

Julis' father first created the software, *Hablando con Julis*, to help his daughter communicate with family and friends. Though it started as a program for individuals with oral and verbal communication difficulties, it has also grown to become valuable for those with Down syndrome, cerebral palsy, autism, cognitive impairment, and those with communication and learning disabilities.

Thanks to the support of Give To Colombia and Cisco Systems Inc., *Hablando con Julis*' software can now be used for free on any computer or mobile device, through the website: www.hablandoconjulis.org. This partnership also allowed the organization to improve the software's interface in order to make it more user-friendly and interactive as well as translate it to English, among other enhancements. Our model at Give To Colombia proved to be the right platform for providing schools and homes worldwide with access to this software.

The principal idea behind our project, “Colombia Gives Back- Art Vintage Bill Collection,” is to demonstrate that when you invest in Colombia, like we do at G2C, you receive much more in return. We have conceptualized our Colombia Gives Back Experience in a project that consists of taking antique bills that have been provided by the Colombian Central Bank (Banco de la República) and giving them to some of our favorite Colombian celebrities, including artists, athletes, musicians and others, to “personalize” these bills in a way that adds value to them.
